We Stay Wildcat Strong!

The grant program has officially been suspended for the remainder of the 2019/20 school year, and the money will be rolled into next year's grants set to begin in the fall. As we get closer to the start of the next school year, we'll fill everyone in on how grants will be handled.

In the meantime, we are getting ready for next year, and that means PTO board elections! Anyone who is a parent or guardian of a child enrolled at Circle Grove, Rockville, or Broadmoor is eligible to serve on the board. The following board positions must be voted upon and filled for the 2020/21 school year:

Vice President (becomes president during second year of service) - Responsible for supporting President and acting as President if necessary.

Junior Treasurer (becomes Sr. Treasurer during second year) - Responsible for finances of the PTO in coordination with the Sr. Treasurer.

Recording Secretary - Records and publishes meeting minutes and submits district forms as directed by the President and Vice President.

Media Secretary - Responsible for newsletters, social media, and coordinating information with the district.

Member-at-Large - Supports other members as determined by the board.

Rockville/Circle Grove Representative -AND- Broadmoor Representative - Attends school functions, drives membership at schools, responsible for PTO's bulletin boards at each school.

If you would like to nominate yourself for a position, please email lespto@outlook.com for more information on any position you're interested in. We have detailed job descriptions and can give you a good idea of how many hours each position tends to take per month. We ask that you send us a short bio with your name, position you're interested in, grades levels of your children, and why you think you'd be a good fit for that position if you decide to run. We will be posting the bios on our Facebook page prior to voting.

So how will voting work?

We'll be creating a Facebook event where we will post the bios of anyone running for a position on the board. Please note that we will have comments and posting by the community disabled. Voting will be done via anonymous survey beginning May 19th and closing after 24 hours. You're eligible to vote as long as you have a child in any of the three schools the PTO serves. We're excited to see how next year's board shapes up!

Moving forward

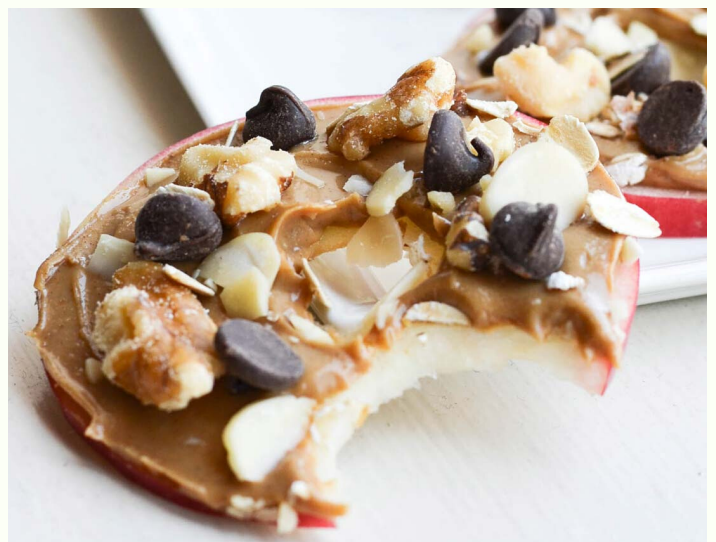

Change in Grab & Go Lunch Schedule

You may have heard the lunch pick up schedule is changing! Starting April 13th, lunch pick up will occur on Mondays and Wednesdays at Broadmoor. On Monday, you will receive two lunches and two breakfasts, while Wednesdays will have three of each meal. Pick up is from 11 -12 and is available for any children in the district ages 1 -18. Just a reminder, the kids do need to be in the car to receive the meals! School packet pick up is also available at Broadmoor in bins in front of the entrance to the commons from 8 -5, Monday through Friday, and from 1 - 3 on Sunday. Thank you to the staff of both schools for putting together lunches, distributing them, and getting the bin system set up!
