The Flamingos Return!

The flamingo flocks are returning to Louisburg! Our first fundraiser of the year was one of the community's favorites from last year, and we can't be more excited! Starting September 17th, you have the opportunity to choose where one of our flocks of 10 yard flamingos will stop off. The flock does have to stay within their migratory boundaries - 223rd to 359th and State Line to New Lancaster Road - and they'll only stay at each location for 24 hours before moving on. The flocks will start their journey at the elementary schools on September 21st, and they'll move on to the homes and businesses you select on the 23rd. The last day for orders is October 2nd, so head over to our website to get your order in early! A single flock is \$20, and if you wish to remain anonymous, the cost is \$30. For those who don't want birds in their yard, you can pay \$30 to become a no-fly zone. We know that some of you will want to get revenge if you're flocked, so the name of who sent the flamingos can be purchased for only \$10! Happy bird watching!
